A parents and spectators expectations and attitudes have a significant bearing on a child's attitude towards:

- Other players
- Officials
- Managers
- Spectators

It is the aim of the Club to ensure that parents/spectators representing Bengeo Tigers are always positive and encouraging towards all of the children, not just their own.

We therefore encourage parents/spectators to:

- Applaud the opposition as well as your own team
- Avoid coaching the child during the game
- Not to shout and scream
- Respect the referees' decision
- Give attention to each of the children involved in football, not just the most talented
- Give encouragement to everyone to participate in football
- Avoid airing grievances concerning your child during the match

I understand that if I do not follow the Code I may be:

- Issued with a verbal warning or asked to leave
- Required to meet with the club committee league or CFA Welfare Officer
- Obliged to undertake an FA education course
- Requested not to attend future games, be suspended or have my membership removed
- Required to leave the club along with any dependents and/or issued a fine.
